Fundraising event descriptions:

- Bingo is one of our biggest fundraisers. Bingo is on Sunday from 2:00pm to 4:30pm. Our workers need to be available from 12:30pm to 5:00pm for setup, selling and cleanup. To cover the need for volunteers, parents, in all grades, will need to volunteer as a kitchen worker or a floor worker. This will insure that Bingo is covered. You will be placed on a team, where the teams are scheduled on a rotating basis. Each team is projected to be scheduled for 2 or 3 Sundays in a year. This will be approximately 5 hours, each Sunday, towards the 35 hour commitment. Please feel free to volunteer additional Sundays.

- Fall Sweepstakes is a fundraiser where we sell a limited number of tickets (1500), for \$30.00 each. Dinner and beer is included in the price as well as a chance to win 26 cash prizes. The grand prize is \$10,000. Volunteers are needed for ticket sales at the door, to sell bell jar, split clubs, theme basket tickets and kitchen workers. Estimated eight hours towards the 35 hour commitment.

- Monte Carlo Night is a fun night of gambling. Tickets are \$15.00 and will include admission, pizza, pop, beer or wine. Games of chance include: Blackjack, money wheels, bell jar sales, split clubs, theme baskets, silent auctions and a treasure chest auction. Volunteers are needed to work the games, sell beer, kitchen workers, door sales, ticket sellers. Estimated eight hours towards the 35 hour commitment.
- Lawn Fete Baskets requires donations and collections of items to be auctioned. Potential hours over a three day period.
- Fish Fry is held during Lent. Volunteers are needed to work in the kitchen, dessert and pop tables and window sales. Estimated four hours each night of the fish fry. Fish Fries are sold for eight nights during Lent.
- Spaghetti Dinner is held in the fall. Volunteers are needed to setup and serve the dinner. Estimated eight hours on the day of the dinner.
- Script is gift cards that are sold after all Masses. Volunteers needed to sell script after each Mass. Estimated two hours each time script is sold after Mass. PTG will be given fundraising credit as of this year. It generated \$5000.00 last year.
- Other fundraisers require a chairperson who needs 3-5 volunteers for packaging/sorting orders /delivery. Potential hours available.

Advertising and Marketing:

- We are looking for a volunteer to assist with advertising and marketing ideas for all events.

School event descriptions:

- Lunchroom Monitors are needed to assist at lunch time in the cafeteria. Lunch is from 11:30am to 1:00pm.
- Parking lot aides are needed to assist the students loading and unloading the buses.
- Library monitors are needed to assist in the library to check out books and accept returned books.
- Halloween and Christmas party volunteers are needed to assist during the event for the children.
